

NOTICE OF VACANCIES

Transactions and Use Tax Citizens Oversight Committee

The Committee is an advisory committee in nature and its purpose is for the review of revenue and expenditure reports as they relate to the receipt and use of Transaction and Use Tax revenue and advise the Council on the use of funds, as assigned in Resolution No. 4257

Meetings: are held quarterly in March, June, September and December.

Terms: There are currently 5 vacancies, each with two-year terms. Terms will begin after appointments are made, on or about, June 3, 2019. Please note the first term will expire on January 31, 2021.

Qualifications: Persons must be 18 years of age or older; may not possess any felony convictions; be residents and registered voters of the City of Port Hueneme; one member shall be a business owner or have qualifications that include budgeting or other relevant areas of fiscal and financial responsibility; may not be elected officials of any government level; or, may not be an employee of, or dependent of an employee, of the City.

Members are appointed by the City Council, with each Council Member appointing one member, and approval of appointment by the majority of the Council.

Applications are being accepted through May 16th at 2:00 p.m. Applications are available on the City's website, or by contacting the City Clerk. They may be emailed or dropped off at City Hall prior to the deadline.
